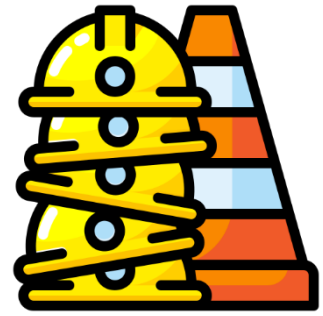
Who is the IOSH Managing Safely Course suitable for?
